Organizing Authority: The organizing authority is the Melbourne Yacht Club.

Rules: This regatta is governed by the *Rules* as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*

Entry and Eligibility: This Regatta is open to PHRF rated boats with Jib and Main use only. Completion of the entry form and liability waiver is required to compete. Ratings can be obtained from the MYC Fleet Director

Entry fees for the series:

First race is free

\$20 MYC member, \$40 for non-members, includes racing and awards.

Sailing Area: Indian River south of the Melbourne Causeway, Rt 192. Starting Buoy is the Rum Race start can.

Sunday June 16, 2019 Moonrise at 7:52pm Start is at 7:00

Tuesday July 16, 2019 Moonrise at 8:24pm Start is at 7:00

Saturday September 14, 2019 Moonrise at 8:07pm Start is at 7:00

Sunday October 13, 2019 Moonrise at 7:12pm Start is at 7:00

Tuesday November 12, 2019 Moonrise at 5:55pm Start is at 6:00

Thursday December 12, 2019 Moonrise at 6:05pm Start is at 6:00

Skippers are to check the MYC Bar white board for the course and start boat. MYC Bar will be open after racing for award presentation. If the race is cancelled for whatever reasons a presentation will take its place.

April is a scheduled Rum Race, August is the Full Moon Regatta, June (Fathers Day) day early due to the late moonrise.

Races: One race around the selected marks as posted on the white board in the MYC Bar. This is PHRF Time on Time scoring; Boats are to use only Main and Jib (genoa)

Starting: All boats will start as One Fleet as defined in RRS 26 (5 minutes). The start/Finish line will be between the Signal Boat and the MYC Rum Race "Blue" Can.

Sailing Instructions: Sailing Instructions will be available at registration and a copy will be posted on the white board in the Bar of MYC

Courses: The courses will be identified on the MYC white board utilizing selected area gov't markers, MYC marks or temporary marks. Approx. .5 miles. The start will be between the RC boat and the Rum Race start mark.

Scoring: Scoring shall be the Low Point System in Appendix A, of the RRS. The best 5 scores will be accumulated to determine the overall winner. Total of all scores will break any tie. PHRF fleet will be scored Time on Time

Awards: 1st 2nd and 3rd will be awarded each race, Overall top 3 will be recognized at the end of the series.
