NOTICE OF RACE

Organizing Authority: The organizing authority is the Melbourne Yacht Club.

Rules: This regatta is governed by the *Rules* as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*

Entry and Eligibility: This Regatta is open to all dinghies with assigned Portsmouth Numbers and less than 20 feet.. Boats without a Portsmouth Number are welcome too. A number will be assigned by the OA, w/o dispute Completion of the entry form and liability waver is required to compete.

Entry fees, per boat:

Adults: \$20 , Includes, racing, awards, beverages and snacks

Sailing Area: Start will be within the Melbourne Harbor, and the Indian River Lagoon, south of the Melbourne Causeway

Races: A total of 2 races are scheduled,. Completion of 1 race constitutes a regatta.

Sailing Instructions: Sailing Instructions will be available at registration and a copy will be posted on the Notice Board in the main hall of MYC

Courses: The courses will be from Melbourne Harbor to Melbourne Beach Pier utilizing Govt. marks, Rum Race marks and temporary inflatable marks. A return race with a more direct route. The course will be within the sailing instructions and posted on the notice board.

Scoring: Scoring shall be the Low Point System in Appendix A of the *RRS*. *Any ties will be decided on the lowest accumulated corrected time.*

Awards: Prizes will be the first boat to finish each race, first through third place corrected for each race and an Overall winner.
